On top of that little lot, 37214 has recently moved from FALY TE to MDTT TI and all of the locomotives in the Eastfield Coal sector FEPE have moved to a new pool FEPM which is based at Motherwell. Of the above 37063/156/196 and 37285 have gone to the Intercity pool IISA on loan, as have 37070/194/209 and 37252 last month. This month sees the concentration of all of the Metals sector 37/0's to Cardiff included in these is 37069, it's first transfer away from Thornaby depot, as far as I am aware. 37145/502 and 37505 have gone into the "holding" pool awaiting transfer to the Petroleum sector, 145 having been in trouble with traction motor problems and 37502 has arrived at Eastfield depot with collision damage. 37420 "The Scottish Hosteller" has returned to Scotland while 37413 "Loch Eil Outward Bound" has gone to Cornwall!

A new Railfreight Distribution freightliner service has started with the commencement of the new timetable. It is the first freightliner to run between Wales and East Anglia departing Pengam Freightliner Terminal at 0625 Mon and Sat excepted arriving at Felixstowe North Terminal at 1757 running with the code 4L65. The return working 4V66 departs Felixstowe at 2315 Friday and Saturdays excepted arriving back in Pengham at 0707 the next day. This is the only daytime working of 37s on 'liners into East Anglia, with the exception of the Ipswich to Felixstowe 'portions'.

Another development in East Anglia is a bar on the use of Class 37 locomotives on ballast trains. The Great Eastern Division of Network SouthEast took the lead with their Divisional Civil Engineer issuing an instruction to stop 37s being used to haul ballast trains on sites where ballast is being dropped. The reason behind this was the safety of engineering staff on site who have to stand on the wagons to release the ballast, who were falling over or even off the wagon when power was applied and the loco moved off with a jerk - the power coming in at once rather than gradually; - an informed source says that this can be overcome with carefull increases on the power handle. As the control system takes a little time to react, some drivers are opening up and then finding that nothing happens so open it up some more - then it all comes at once. The problem is most acute at weekends when resources are stretched and the word from Network SouthEast is to fit the Class 37 fleet with slow speed control in the longer term. Whether or not NSE are willing to pay for other sectors 37s to be fitted remains to be seen. The class are still being used on other engineering trains and trip workings.

LIVERIES

As 37152 has now gone into Doncaster works for overhaul (due out 22nd May) and presumably a new coat of paint, this will leave 37057/128/209 and 37408 as the only machines carrying large logo livery.

Also in that vain, as far as I know, 37217/219 are the only all blue liveried examples.
